Table Topper size – 48" square 4 –16" Napkins

Fabric Requirements and Cutting Directions:

White print 2/3 yard

Cut 4 - 4 1/2" squares, 4 - 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" for geese, 2 - 6 x 16 1/2" , 2 - 6 x 27 1/2"

Light red print 1/4 yard

Cut 1 - 8 1/2" square, 8 - 4 1/2" squares

Green strip 3/4 yard

* Cut 5 - 3 3/4" strips lengthwise (not WOB)

Dark red 1 yard

12 - 5 3/8" squares, 4 - 3 1/2" x 27 1/2", 4 - 8" squares

White stripe 1/2 yard

Cut 5 WOF at 2 1/2" and piece to make 2 - 2 1/2" x 42 1/2", 2 - 2 1/2" x 46 1/2"

Med green 5/8 yard

Cut 5 at 1 1/2" to make 2 - 1 1/2" x 46 1/2", 2 - 1 1/2" x 48 1/2"

Cut for binding 5 WOF at 2 1/2"

Table Topper Assembly:

1 - 8 1/2" light red print (center)

*Make 4 - 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" flying geese units using 8 lt red print 4 1/2" sqs and

4 white print 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" as shown

Use the 4 - 4 1/2" squares white print

Assemble center star (size 16 1/2")

Sew one 6" x 16 1/2" to each size of star

Sew one 6" x 27 1/2" to top and bottom of star

Size now 27 1/2" square

Assemble stripe frame - need 24 - 5" half square triangles

Cut 12 - 5 3/8" squares of dark red - cut in half diagonally to make 24

match this up with green stripe triangle of same size

3 3/4" wide strip of the green stripe running lengthwise flip ruler to cut (check size with dr red triangle

Sew 6 of the half square triangles together per diagram, add a 3 1/2" x 27 1/2" piece of dr red to each set of triangles, (you should have 4 sets).

Sew one set to each side of star

Add a 8" square of dark red to each end of the other two sets and attach to the top and bottom of quilt.

Sew one - 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" of white stripe attach to each side

Sew one - 2 1/2" x 46 1/2" of white stripe to top and bottom

Sew one - 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" med green strip to each side of quilt

Sew one - 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" med green strip to top and bottom of quilt.

Fuse a 5" strip of Wonder Under to the back of green stripe cut a 60 degree tree.

Fuse a small piece of light red print and med green print and cut out star and trunk per template.

Using satin stitch and variegated thread go around each fused piece.

Quilt as desired and bind using med green.

Napkins:

1 Cut 4 - 17" squares of cream print, Turn 1/4" then turn under another 1/4" press and top stitch around.

2 Fuse a 3 1/2" strip of Wonder Under to the back of green stripe cut a 60 degree tree or use template. Fuse a small piece of red fabric and cut out star and trunk per template.

3 Using satin stitch and variegated thread go around each fused piece.
