

## Morning, Noon, and Night Throw

Size: 52 1/2" x 58 1/2"

### Materials

1/2 yd Tan Houses	1/8 yd Blue Check
1/2 yd Navy Houses	1/3 yd Rust Check
1/2 yd Lt Rust Houses	1/3 yd Tan Vine
1/8 yd Tan Stars	1/4 yd Dk Brown Vine
1/4 yd Navy Stars	1/4 yd Dk Olive Vine
1 yd Rust Stars	3/8 yd Cream Sprigs
1/4 yd Cream Check	3/8 yd Red Sprigs
1/4 yd Tan Check	1/4 yd Lt Olive Sprigs

### Cut the Fabrics

WOF = width of fabric LOF = length of fabric

From the Tan Houses cut:

- 2 – 10 1/2" x 16 1/2" LOF rectangles
- 2 – 5 1/2" squares, fussy cut  
(one house in center of each)

From the Navy Houses cut:

- 2 – 10 1/2" x 16 1/2" LOF rectangles
- 1 – 5 1/2" square, fussy cut  
(one house in center)

From the Lt Rust Houses cut:

- 1 – 10 1/2" x 14 1/2" LOF rectangle
- 2 – 10 1/2" x 4 1/2" LOF rectangles
- 1 – 5 1/2" square, fussy cut  
(one house in center)

From the Tan Stars cut:

- 4 – 3 3/4" squares

From the Navy Stars cut:

- 2 – 2 1/2" WOF strips

From the Rust Stars cut:

- 5 – 4 1/2" WOF strips,  
pieced together end to end (outer border)
- 8 – 3" squares
- 2 – 2 1/2" WOF strips

From the Cream Check cut:

- 2 – 2 1/2" WOF strips

- 4 – 3 3/4" squares

From the Tan Check cut:

- 2 – 2 1/2" WOF strips

From the Blue Check cut:

- 4 – 3" squares
- 4 – 3 3/4" squares

From the Rust Check cut:

- 4 – 2 1/2" WOF strips

From the Tan Vine cut:

- 4 – 3" squares
- 2 – 2 1/2" WOF strips

From the Dk Brown Vine cut:

- 2 – 2 1/2" WOF strips

From the Dk Olive Vine cut:

- 8 – 3" squares
- 8 – 3 3/4" squares

From the Cream Sprigs cut:

- 8 – 3 3/4" squares
- 2 – 2 1/2" WOF strips

From the Red Sprigs cut:

- 2 – 1 1/2" WOF inner sashing strips
- 5 – 1 1/2" WOF strips,  
pieced together end to end (inner border)

From the Lt Olive Sprigs cut:

- 8 – 3" squares
- 4 – 3 3/4" squares

### Instructions

#### Step 1. Hourglass Blocks

**a** Lightly draw a pencil line diagonally across the wrong side of a Cream Check 3 3/4" square. Place it right-sides-together with a Lt Olive Sprig 3 3/4" square. Sew 1/4" away from the drawn line on each side (**fig. 1**). Cut apart on the drawn line. Press. Trim squares, if needed, to 3 3/8". Repeat to make a total of four squares.

**b** Cut the pieced squares in half on the diagonal opposing the seam (**fig. 2**). Pair up the triangles to make hourglass blocks (**fig. 3**). Sew and press. Repeat to make a total of eight hourglass blocks measuring 3" square.
