Baby Quilt

Finished size: 44" x 44"

Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

The instructions are written for the blue quilt. If you prefer to make the pink please use the instructions in parentheses.

- 3/8 yd Blue Patch Y0353-30 (Y0353-42)
- 1/4 yd Blue Circles Y0354-30 (Y0354-42)
- 3/8 yd Yellow Stripe Y0355-9 (Y0355-30)
- 1 yd Green Tonal Y0356-23 (same)
- 1/2 yd Aqua Tonal Y0356-33 (Y0356-30)
- 1/2 yd Yellow Tonal Y0356-9 (Y0354-9)
- 3/4 yd Blue Bug Y0357-30 (Y0357-42)
- 3 yd Backing of your choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric
LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Blue Patch (Pink Patch) cut:
4 - 9 1/2" squares

From the Blue Circles (Pink Circles) cut:

20 - 3 1/2" squares

From the Yellow Stripe (Blue Stripe) cut:

4 - 2" x WOF strips

From the Green Tonal (same) cut:

5 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips (binding)

2 - 2" x 33 1/2" strips

4 - 2" x 30 1/2" strips

6 - 2" x 9 1/2" strips

5 - 3" circles from template

From the Aqua Tonal (Blue Tonal) cut:

20 - 3 1/2" squares

2 - 2" x WOF strips

From the Yellow Tonal (Yellow Circles) cut:

2 - 2" x WOF strips

60 - 2 1/2" squares

From the Blue Bug (Pink Bug) cut:

1 - 4 1/2" x 28 1/2" strip

1 - 4 1/2" x 26 1/2" strip

1 - 4 1/2" x 22 1/2" strip

1 - 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" strip

1 - 4 1/2" square

2 - 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

1 - 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle

60 - 2 1/2" squares

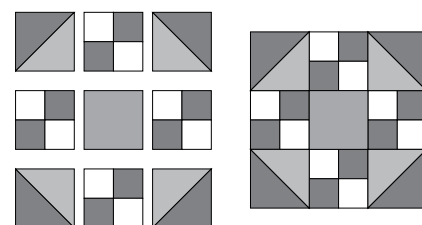
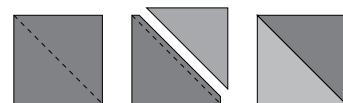
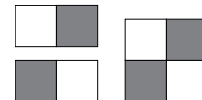
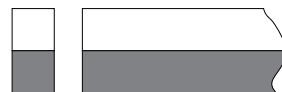
5 - 3 1/2" squares (fussy cut for center of pieced blocks)

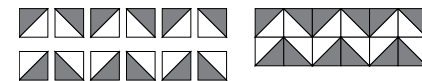
Pieced Block - Finished Size: 9" square

- Create a strip set by sewing the 2" x WOF Yellow Tonal (Yellow Circle) to the 2" x WOF Aqua Tonal (Blue Tonal) lengthwise and press. Repeat to make two strip sets. Cut the strip sets into forty 2" sections.
- Sew two of these sections together to create a four-patch block. Repeat to make twenty four-patch blocks.
- With right sides together, place a 3 1/2" Aqua Tonal (Blue Tonal) square on top of a 3 1/2" Blue Circle (Pink Circle) square and sew across it diagonally. Trim the seam allowance to within a 1/4" of the seam and press open. Repeat to make a total of twenty.
- Referring to the diagram, layout the units you have created above and the 3 1/2" Blue Bug (Pink Bug) square watching for directional placement. Sew the units into rows and press. Then sew the rows together. Repeat for a total of five blocks.



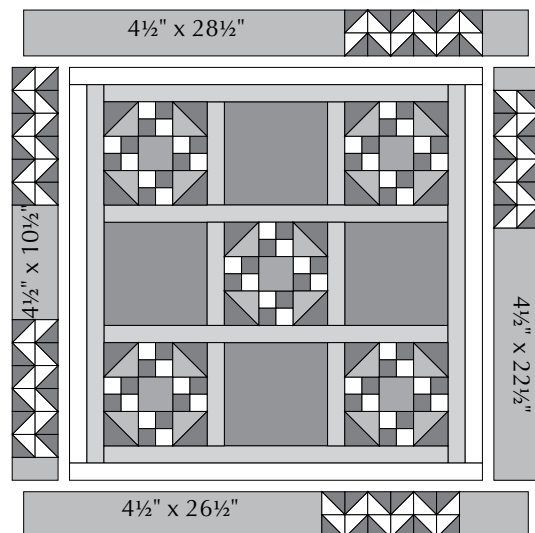
Caterpillar - Finished Size: 4" x 12"

- Referring to step 3 above, place a 2 1/2" Blue Bug (Pink Bug) square on top of a 2 1/2" Yellow Tonal (Yellow Circle) square and sew across it diagonally. Trim the seam allowance and press open (Hint: To help match your points in the next step, it may be helpful to press the seam allowances in one direction on half and the other direction on the other half). Repeat to make a total of sixty.
- Referring to the diagram, layout twelve of the units from step 1 as shown. Sew the units into rows and press. Then sew the rows together. Repeat to make five caterpillar strips.



Putting It Together

- Referring to color photo and watching directional placement, layout pieced blocks and 9 1/2" Blue Patch (Pink Patch) squares in rows, place a 2" x 9 1/2" Green Tonal (same) rectangle between each unit in the row. Sew the rows together and press toward the Green Tonal (same).
- Layout the rows from step 1 placing a 2" x 30 1/2" Green Tonal (same) strip between each row and at the top and bottom. Sew the rows and strips together, press toward the strips. Sew a 2" x 33 1/2" Green Tonal strip to the left and right sides; press toward the strips.
- Sew a Yellow Stripe (Blue Stripe) strip to the right and left sides of the quilt top, press and trim excess. Repeat for the top and bottom.
- Referring to the diagram sew the Blue Bug (Pink Bug) strips, squares, rectangles and caterpillar strips together then add them to the right, left, top and bottom of the quilt.
- Referring to the color photo, appliqu  the 3" Green Tonal (same) circles onto the caterpillar border using your favorite method. For the eyes, embroider or appliqu  on small circles.
- Layer top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Add binding to quilt.
