Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

Fabric A - 1/4 Yard of SKU 17040-1

Fabric B - 3/4 Yard of SKU 17040-2

Fabric C - 1/2 Yard of SKU 17041-2

Fabric D - 1/4 Yard of SKU 17041-4

Fabric E - 1/4 Yard of SKU 17042-3

Fabric F - 1/2 Yard of SKU 17043-1

Fabric G - 1/4 Yard of SKU 17043-2

Fabric H - 1/2 Yard of SKU 17043-5

Fabric I - 1/3 Yard of SKU 17044-5

Fabric J - 1/2 Yard of SKU 17045-3

Fabric K - 1/4 Yard of SKU 17045-4

Fabric L - 1/3 Yard of SKU 17045-5

Binding - 1/2 Yard - SKU 17042-3

Backing - 3 1/2 Yards your choice

Cut the Fabrics

From Fabric A cut:

- 8 - 3 1/2" squares

From Fabric B cut:

- 22 - 4 7/8" squares
- 6 - 3 7/8" squares
- 6 - 2 1/2" squares

From Fabric C cut:

- 22 - 4 7/8" squares

From Fabric D cut:

- 8 - 3 1/2" squares

From Fabric E cut:

- 4 - 3 7/8" squares
- 4 - 2 1/2" squares

From Fabric F cut:

- 12 - 3 1/2" squares

From Fabric G cut:

- 4 - 3 7/8" squares
- 4 - 2 1/2" squares

From Fabric H cut:

- 10 - 3 7/8" squares
- 40 - 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 4 - 2 1/2" squares

From Fabric I cut:

- 4 - 3 7/8" squares
- 16 - 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

From Fabric J cut:

- 6 - 3 7/8" squares
- 2 - 2 1/2 x 32 1/2" strips
- 2 - 2 1/2 x 40 1/2" strips

From Fabric K cut:

- 12 - 3 1/2" squares

From Fabric L cut:

- 6 - 3 7/8" squares
- 24 - 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

Directions

1. Place one 3 7/8" Fabric J square on top of one 3 7/8" Fabric H square, right sides together. (Fig. 1) Draw a diagonal line through the center of the cream block. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the diagonal line. (Fig 2)
2. Cut the square on the drawn line to make two half-square triangle squares. (Fig. 3) Open each half-square triangle and press towards the dark. (Fig. 4)
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make the following half-square triangle sets: six H/J, six L/B, four I/G, four H/E and forty-four B/C.

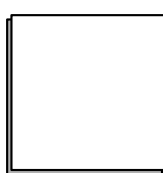

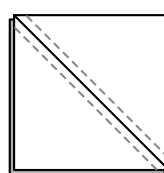

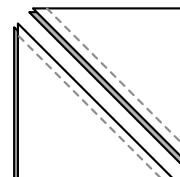

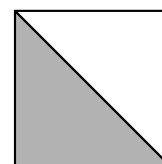
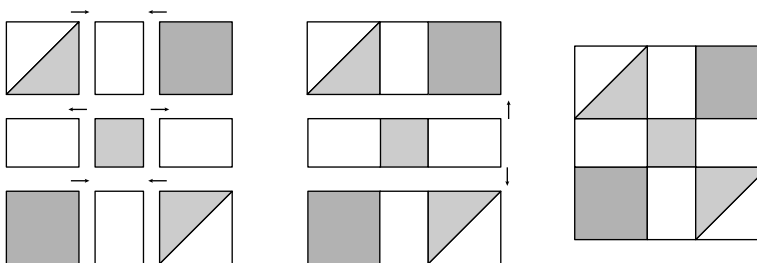


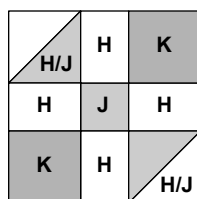

4. Layout two H/J half-square triangles, one 2 1/2" Fabric J square, two 3 1/2" Fabric K squares and four 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric H rectangles. (See Block Assembly Diagram)

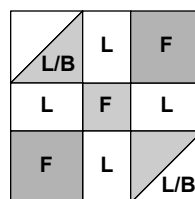


Block Assembly Diagram

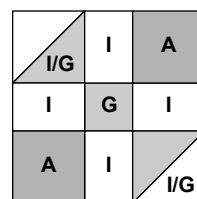
5. Sew together the pieces in each row, pressing the seam allowances in opposite directions for each row. Join the rows together to complete the block. Finished block should measure 8 1/2" inches including seam allowances.
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 to make the following blocks:



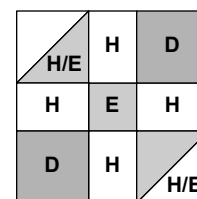
Block A - Make 6

7. Following the quilt photo for the quilt top layout, sew the 20 blocks into five rows of four blocks. Sew the rows together to make the quilt center.
8. Sew one Fabric J 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" strip to each side of the quilt center. Add a 2 1/2" Fabric H square to either end of the two 2 1/2" x 32 1/2" Fabric J strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
9. Sew together the pieced borders by joining 11 Fabric B/Fabric C half-square triangles into four 3 1/2" x 43 1/2" border strips.
10. Sew one border strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew the remaining two border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt top.
11. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
