Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1 - Panel (90350-1M)
- 1/4 yard - Green Trees (90353-4M)
- 1/4 yard - Purple Presents (90354-5M)
- 1/4 yard - Pink Stockings (90355-7M)
- 1/4 yard - Red Ornaments (90352-2M)
- 1/4 yard - Green Ornaments (90352-4M)
- 1/4 yard - Aqua Stockings (90355-6M)
- 1/8 yard - Green Holly (90356-4M)
- 3/8 yard - Black Metallic Dots (90330-1M)
- 3/8 yard - Purple Stars (90333-8M) or Blue Stars (90333-2M)
- 3/8 yard - Red Stripe (90331-3M)
- 1/2 yard - Red Stars for Binding (90333-3M)
- 1 1/4 yards - Backing of your choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

From the Purple Stars cut:

- 2 - 2 1/2" WOF strips.
- 2 - 3" WOF strips.

From the Red Stripe cut:

- 2 - 2 1/2" x 25 1/2" strips from WOF
- 2 - 3" x 26 1/2" strips from WOF

From the Green Holly cut:

- 4 - 2 1/2" x 3" rectangles.

From the Black Metallic Dots cut:

- 5 - 1 3/4" WOF strips, sub cut into 112 - 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares.

From each of the following 1/4 yard cut: Green Ornaments, Pink Stockings, Green Trees, Purple Presents

- 5 - 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares.

From each of the following 1/4 yard cut: Red Ornaments, Aqua Stockings

- 4 - 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" squares.

From the Red Stars cut:

- 4 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

Assemble the Quilt Center

1. Trim the Bountiful Blessings panel, 20 1/2" wide by 22 1/2" tall.
2. Sew a 3" x WOF Purple Stars strip to the side edges of the panel; press away from the panel. Trim the excess fabric from each strip flush with the top and bottom edges of the panel. (Fig. 1)

3. Sew a 2 1/2" x WOF Purple Stars strip to top & bottom edges of the panel; press away from the panel. Trim the excess fabric from each strip flush with the side edges of the panel.
4. The panel, with borders added, should measure 25 1/2" x 26 1/2".

Add the Inner Border

1. Sew a 3" x 26 1/2" Red Stripe strip to the side edges of the panel; press away from the panel.
2. Sew a 2 1/2" x 3" Green Holly rectangle to each end of the two 2 1/2" x 25 1/2" Red Stripe strips. Sew these two units to the top and bottom edges of the panel; press away from the panel.
3. The quilt center should measure 30 1/2" x 30 1/2" square.

Assemble the Snowball Blocks

1. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the 112 - 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" Black Metallic Dot squares.
2. Place a Black Metallic Dot square on the corner of a 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" Snowball square. Sew along the drawn line and trim corner 1/4" from the stitching line; press the seam open. (Fig. 2)
3. Repeat this process for each of the remaining three corners. (Fig. 3)
4. Repeat this step with each of the 5 1/2" Snowball squares to make a total of 28 Snowball blocks.

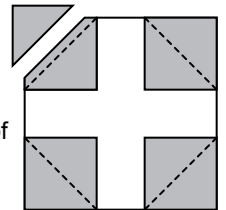

Assemble the Quilt

1. Sew together 6 Snowball blocks, end-to-end. Sew the strip of Snowball blocks to one side edge of the quilt center. Repeat on the opposite edge.
2. Sew together 8 Snowball blocks, end-to-end. Sew the strip of Snowball blocks to the top edge of the quilt. Repeat on the bottom edge. Press seams towards the center of the quilt.
3. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and baste. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting from around the borders and square the corners.
4. Sew the binding to the quilt.
