## Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1/8 yd Plaid (Y0426-45)
- 7/8 yd Purple Tonal (Y0427-28)
- 1/4 yd Turquoise Tonal (Y0427-33)
- 1/4 yd Violet Tonal (Y0427-45)
- 1 3/8 yd Turq. Butterfly Print (Y0428-32)
- 1/4 yd Pink Butterfly Toss (Y0429-44)
- 1/4 yd Pink Dot (Y0430-44)
- 3/8 yd Turquoise Dot (Y0430-32)
- 1 1/2 yd White Dot (Y0430-1)
- 3 1/4 yd Backing of your choice

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

### From the Plaid cut:

- 6 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 2 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/4" rectangles

### From the Purple Tonal cut:

- 6 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips (binding)
- 4 - 1 1/2" x WOF strips
- 4 - 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 4 - 4" x 3 1/2" rectangles

### From the Turquoise Tonal cut:

- 2 - 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 2 - 4" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 2 - 4" x 3" rectangles
- 2 - 4" x 2 1/4" rectangles
- 2 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/4" rectangles
- 2 - 2" squares
- 2 - 1 1/2" squares

### From the Violet Tonal cut:

- 4 - 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 4 - 4" x 3 1/2" rectangles

### From the Turq. Butterfly Print cut:

- 2 - 5 1/2" LOF strips
- 3 - 5 1/2" WOF strips

### From the Pink Butterfly Toss cut:

- 2 - 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 2 - 4" x 3 1/2" rectangles
- 2 - 4" x 3" rectangles
- 2 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/4" rectangles

### From the Pink Dot cut:

- 4 - 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles
- 4 - 2" squares
- 4 - 1 1/2" squares

### From the Turquoise Dot cut:

- 8 - 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles
- 2 - 4" x 2 1/4" rectangles
- 10 - 2" squares
- 10 - 1 1/2" squares

### From the White Dot cut:

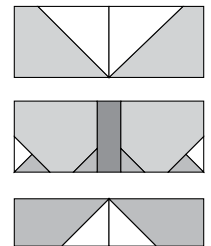
- 2 - 15 3/8" squares, cut twice diagonally
- 2 - 8" squares, cut once diagonally
- 4 - 2" x 10 1/2" rectangles
- 4 - 2" x 7 1/2" rectangles
- 12 - 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles
- 12 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles
- 12 - 3 1/2" squares
- 4 - 3" squares
- 12 - 2 1/2" squares
- 4 - 2 1/4" squares
- 16 - 2" squares

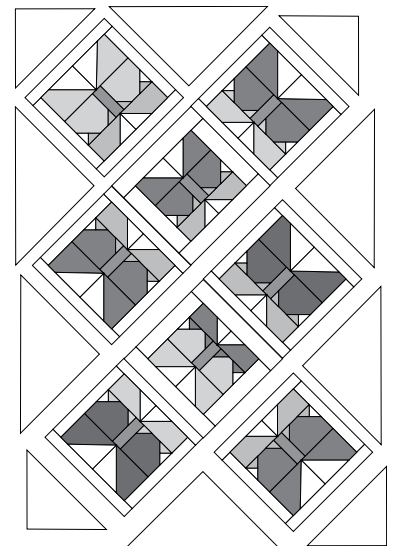
### Butterfly Blocks - Finished Size: 10" square

1. Place a 3 1/2" White Dot square on the right top corner of a 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" Pink Butterfly Toss and sew across it diagonally. Trim the seam allowance to within 1/4" of the seam, press. Repeat this time putting the 3 1/2" White Dot square on the left top of 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" Pink Butterfly Toss rectangle. Then sew the two units together to create the top. Repeat to make a total of six using the remaining 3 1/2" White Dot squares and 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" Purple, Violet and Turquoise Tonal rectangles.
2. Repeat step 1 using the 3" White Dot squares and the 4" x 3" Turquoise Tonal and Pink Butterfly Toss rectangles. Repeat to make a total of two small wing tops.
3. Place a 2" White Dot square on top of a 2" Turquoise Dot square and sew across it diagonally. Trim the seam allowance and press. Repeat using the remaining 2" White Dot squares and the 2" Turquoise Dot, Turquoise Tonal and Pink Dot squares. Make a total of sixteen.
4. Place Turquoise Dot/White Dot unit you completed in step 3 on the bottom left corner of a 4" x 3 1/2" Pink Butterfly Toss rectangle, sew across it diagonally, trim and press. Then place a 1 1/2" Turquoise Dot on the bottom right corner and sew across it diagonally, trim and press. Repeat this step reversing the placement of the unit from step 3 and the 1 1/2" Turquoise Dot square. Then sew the two units you just completed on the right and left side of a 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Plaid rectangle. Repeat using the 4" x 3 1/2" Purple, Violet and Turquoise Tonal rectangles and 1 1/2" Pink Dot, Turquoise Dot and Green Tonal to make a total of six large middle sections. Refer to the diagram and color photo for fabric placement.
5. Repeat step 4 using the remaining units from step 3, the 3 1/2" x 3 1/4" Pink Butterfly Toss and Turquoise Tonal rectangles and the 1 1/2" Turquoise Dot and Turquoise Tonal squares. Sew these units to the right and left sides of a 1 1/2" x 3 1/4" Plaid rectangle. Make two small middle sections.
6. Place a 2 1/2" White Dot square on the lower right corner of a 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" Turquoise Dot rectangle and sew across it diagonally, trim and press. Repeat this time putting the 2 1/2" White Dot square on the lower left side of a 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" Turquoise Dot rectangle. Then sew the two units together to create the bottom section. Repeat to make six using the remaining 2 1/2" White Dot squares and the 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" Turquoise and Pink Dot rectangles.
7. Repeat step 6 using the 2 1/4" White Dot squares and the 4" x 2 1/4" Turquoise Dot and Turquoise Tonal rectangles. Make two small bottom wing sections.
8. Layout the top, middle and bottom of the large and small butterflies, referring to the color diagram. Sew the sections together, press.
9. Sew the 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" White Dot rectangles to the right and left sides of the large butterflies, press. Then sew the 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" White Dot rectangles to the top and bottom, press. Repeat for the two smaller butterflies using the 2" x 7 1/2" White Dot strips for the right and left sides and the 2" x 10 1/2" on top and bottom.



### Putting It Together

1. Lay out the blocks and side triangles as shown, sew them into diagonal rows, press. Then sew the rows together and add the corner triangles, press.
2. Sew the 1 1/2" x LOF Purple Tonal strips end to end to make one long strip. Sew this to right side of quilt top, press, trim excess. Repeat on the left, top and bottom.
3. Watching directional placement, sew the 5 1/2" x LOF strips to the right and left sides and trim excess. Repeat with the 5 1/2" x WOF strips for the top and bottom.
4. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.
