Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1-1/4 yds Brown Floral (KEUP024-15)
- 1/2 yd Dk Purple Vine (KEUP026-28)
- 1/4 yd Cream Herbs (KEUP028-2)
- 3/4 yd Lt Pink Floral (KEUP029-41)
- 3/4 yd Lt Wine Swag (KEUP030-47)
- 1/8 yd Wine Vine (KEUP026-48)
- 1/8 yd Purple Vine (KEUP026-27)
- 1/8 yd Dk Green Swag (KEUP030-22)
- 1/8 yd Gray Herbs (KEUP028-6)
- 1/8 yd Wine Floral (KEUP024-48)
- 1/8 yd Olive Grid (KEUP025-24)
- 1/8 yd Gray Grid (KEUP025-6)
- 1/2 yd Brown Swag (KEUP030-15)
- (binding)
- 2-3/4 yds Backing of choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From Brown Floral cut:

- 3 – 4 1/2" x WOF strips (border)
- 3 – 3" x WOF strips (border)
- 4 – 5 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
- 2 – 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
- 6 – 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles
- 10 – 2-1/2" squares
- 19 – 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
- 4 – 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

From Dk Purple Vine cut:

- 10 – 1 1/2" x WOF strips

From Cream Herbs cut:

- 4 – 1 1/2" x WOF strips

From Lt Pink Floral cut:

- 11 – 1 1/2" x WOF strips
- 8 – 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

From Lt Wine Swag cut:

- 14 – 1 1/2" x WOF strips

From each of the following- Wine Vine, Purple Vine, Dk Green Swag, Gray Herbs, Olive Grid and Gray Grid cut:

- 3 – 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles

From Wine Floral cut:

- 4 – 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles

From Brown Swag cut:

- 6 – 2 1/2" x WOF strips (binding)

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. Clothworks is not responsible for printing errors.

Directions

Making Block A

1. Sew together a panel of a Lt Pink Floral 1 1/2" x WOF strip and a Lt Wine Swag 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Press the seam towards the darker fabric (figure 1). Repeat to make ten panels of these two fabrics. Cut forty-four 5 1/2" lengths (A patch) and forty-four 2 1/2" lengths (B patch) from the panels.
2. Sew together a unit of two 5 1/2" x 2 1/2" A patches and one Wine Floral 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangle making one C unit (figure 2). Repeat to make four C units from Wine Floral. Press the seams toward the center rectangle.
3. Repeat Step 2 to make three C units each of the remaining A patches and colored 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles, making a total of twenty-two C units.
4. Sew together a panel of a Cream Herbs 1 1/2" x WOF strip and a Dk Purple Vine 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Press the seams towards the darker fabric. Repeat to make four panels. Cut one hundred-twelve 1 1/2" wide sections from the panels. (Reserve 24 for Blocks B, C and D)
5. Sew together a panel of a Dk Purple Vine 1 1/2" x WOF strip and a Lt Wine Swag 1 1/2" x WOF strip; press. Repeat to make four panels. Cut eighty-eight 1 1/2" wide sections from the panels.
6. Sew together one section from Step 4 and one section from Step 5 into a D patch (figure 3). Press the unit. Make a total of eighty-eight D patches.
7. Assemble one C unit, two B patches and four D patches (figure 4). Note placement of lightest patches. Sew the patches into rows. Sew the rows together to make one Block A. Press. Repeat to make twenty-two Block A's.

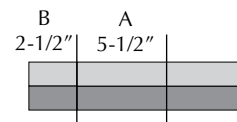

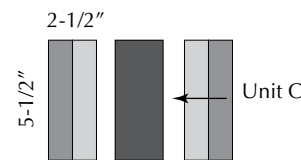

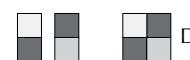

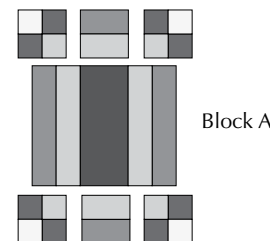

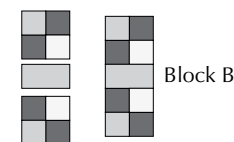
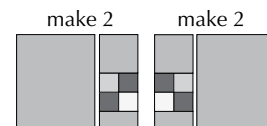
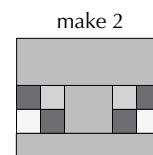

Making Block B

1. Sew together a panel of one Dk Purple Vine 1 1/2" x WOF strip and one Lt Pink Floral 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Press the seam towards the darker fabric; cut twenty-four 1 1/2" slices from the panel.
2. Sew into a four patch one section just made and one section from Step 4 (above) (figure 5). Press the unit to make an E patch. Repeat to make twenty-four E patches. (Reserve 8 for Blocks C and D)
3. Make a Block B by sewing together two E patches and one Lt Pink Floral 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle (figure 6). Note placement of lighter patches. Press. Repeat to make eight B Blocks.

Making Blocks C and D

1. For Block C sew together an E patch with a Brown Floral 2-1/2" square and a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle (figure 7). Sew a 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to one side. Make four total, two of each as shown.
2. For Block D sew together two E patches with one Brown Floral 2-1/2" square; then sew one Brown Floral 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle and one 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to each long side (figure 8). Make 2.

Sewing the Blocks into Rows (vertical rows)

1. Following the quilt picture, for Row 1 (first narrow vertical row), sew four B blocks alternately with three Brown Floral 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles. Sew a 2 1/2" square to each end. Repeat to make Row 7.
2. Sew together four Block A's alternating with three Brown Floral 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for Row 2. Repeat to make Rows 4 and 6. Sew Row 1 (from above) to Row 2; press. Sew Block C's to the top and bottom of Row 1-2. Repeat with Rows 6 and 7.
3. Sew five Block A's and four 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles together to make Rows 3 and 5.

Finishing the Quilt

1. Sew the seven block rows together as shown in the quilt picture. Press the top.
2. Measure the length of the quilt center; piece and trim two 4 1/2" borders and sew to the left and right sides of the quilt. Press the seams outward.
3. Measure the width of the quilt center; piece and trim two 3" borders. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press the seams outward.
4. Layer, baste and quilt as desired. Trim off the excess backing and batting from around the outside border.
5. Make the binding from Brown Swag and apply to the quilt.
