## Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

3/4 yard-Blue Main Print (Y0254-1)

1/2 yard-Blue Tonal (Y0253-1)

1-1/2 yards-Cream Tonal (Y0253-2)

2-1/2 yard-Brown Tonal (Y0253-4)

(includes binding)

1/3 yard-Green Gear Toss (Y0255-3)

5/8 yard-Green Hills (Y0252-3)

3-1/3 yards-Backing (suggested Cream

Gear Toss (Y0255-2)

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

### From the Blue Main Print cut:

9 – 6-1/4" diagonally centered squares of RV's

### From the Blue Tonal cut:

18 – 5" squares: cut once on diagonal

### From the Cream Tonal cut:

4 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips

11 – 3-1/2" x WOF strips sewn end to end

to make:

2 – 3-1/2" x 42-1/2" border strips

4 – 3-1/2" x 52-1/2" border strips

2 – 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" border strips

### From the Brown Tonal cut:

12 – 4-1/2" squares

11 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips

(4 strips for strip sets)

7 strips sewn end to end to make:

2 – 2-1/2" x 68-1/2" border strips

2 – 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" border strips

7 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips (binding)

### From the Green Gear Toss cut:

12 – 4-1/2" squares

### From the Green Hills cut:

4 – 4-1/2" LOF strips (parallel to selvage)

then cut

4 – 4-1/2" x WOF (24") strips

(perpendicular to selvage)

## Directions

### Assemble RV Blocks

1. Center and pencil a 6-1/4" square "on point" around 9 RV's. Cut out on the lines. (Figure 1)
2. Finger press a fold in the center of one side of a RV 6-1/4" square. Find the center of a Blue Tonal triangle cut from the 5" Blue Tonal squares. Match centers and sew together. (Figure 2) Press the unit open. Repeat to add 4 triangles to the square. Press the block and trim to 8-1/2". Repeat to complete 9 RV blocks. (Figure 3)

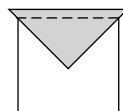

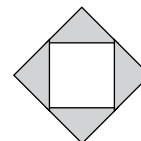

### Assemble the Four Patch Blocks

1. Lay out two Brown Tonal 4-1/2" squares and two Green Gear Toss 4-1/2" squares. Sew squares together into a block and press. Repeat to make six 8-1/2" blocks. (Figure 4)

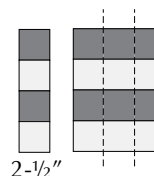

### Assemble the Road Border

1. Sew two 2-1/2" x WOF Brown Tonal strips to two 2-1/2" Cream Tonal strips, alternating light and dark. Press seams toward the dark strips. Repeat for a second four-strip set. Cut these strip sets into twenty-six 2-1/2" sections. (Fig. 5)
2. Sew six sections together end to end for the top border. Remove one dark square from one end. Press seams toward the dark fabric. Repeat for the bottom border.
3. Sew seven sections together end to end for a side border. Sew a dark square from step 2 to the light end. Press seams toward the dark fabric. Repeat for a second side border.

### Assemble the Quilt

1. Sew the six four patch blocks and the nine RV blocks into three rows as shown in the quilt picture. Sew the rows together and press the seams.
2. Sew two 4-1/2" x LOF Green Hills strips together end-to-end. Trim to 4-1/2" x 40-1/2". Repeat with the two remaining LOF strips. Sew these strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Press the seams outward. Sew two 4-1/2" LOF strips together, trim to 4-1/2" x 32-1/2". Sew a 4-1/2" x 32-1/2" strip to the top and bottom sides of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
3. Piece two border strips from the Brown Tonal 2-1/2" WOF strips that are 2-1/2" x 48-1/2". Sew one to the left and right sides of the quilt center and press seams outward. Trim two lengths from the Brown Tonal strips to 2-1/2" x 36-1/2" and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
4. Sew a 3-1/2" x 52-1/2" Cream Tonal border to each side of the quilt center. Sew a 3-1/2" x 42-1/2" Cream Tonal border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press seams outward.
5. Sew the road border strips (2-1/2" x 58-1/2") to each side of the quilt center. Sew the 2-1/2" x 46-1/2" road strips to the top and bottom. Press.
6. Sew a 3-1/2" x 62-1/2" Cream Tonal border strip to each side. Sew a 3-1/2" x 52-1/2" strip to the top and bottom.
7. Sew a 2-1/2" x 68-1/2" Brown Tonal border strip to each side of the center. Sew a 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" strip to the top and bottom.
8. Layer with batting and backing, quilt and bind to finish.
