Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 2/3 Yard or one Panel - (23090-1)
- 1 1/3 Yard - Stripe (23091-1)
- 1/2 Yard - Green Cups (23092-2)
- 3/8 Yard - Dark Brown Beans (23093-1)
- 1/2 Yard - Aqua Beans (23093-3)
- 1/8 Yard - Green Swirls (23094-2)
- 2/3 Yard - Caramel Swirls (23094-4)
- 1/3 Yard - Rust Swirls (23094-6)
- 3 Yards backing of your choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Panel fussy cut:

- 1 – Trim around the outside of the panel images.

From the Stripe fussy cut:

- 2 – 4 1/2" x 34 1/2" LOF strips (top and bottom of outside border)
- 2 – 4 1/2" x 44 1/2" LOF strips (sides of outside border)

From the Green Cups cut:

- 2 – 3 1/2" x 36 1/2" strips
- 2 – 3 1/2" x 32 1/2" strips

From the Dark Brown Beans cut:

- 64 – 2 1/2" squares

From the Aqua Beans cut:

- 6 – 2 1/2" x WOF (5 of these will be used for the binding)

From the Green Swirls cut:

- 1 – 2 1/2" x WOF

From the Caramel Swirls cut:

- 2 – 2 1/2" x WOF
- 2 – 3 1/2" x WOF
- 16 – 4 1/2" squares

From the Rust Swirls cut:

- 1 – 2 1/2" x WOF
- 2 – 1 1/2" x 34 1/2"
- 2 – 1 1/2" x 26 1/2"

Directions

Blocks Finished size: 4 1/2" square

1. Place a 2 1/2" Dark Brown Bean square on the corner of a 4 1/2" Caramel Swirls Square and sew across it diagonally. Trim the corner to within 1/4" of the seam and press out. Repeat on the remaining corners. Make a total of sixteen blocks.

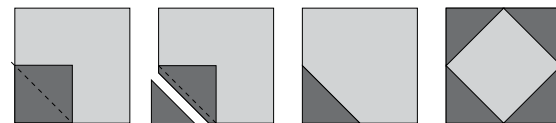

2. Sew six of the blocks completed above into a row and press. Repeat to make a total of two rows.

Putting it Together

1. Sew a 3 1/2" x WOF Caramel Swirls strip to the right and left edges of the panel. Trim the excess fabric from the strip where it extends past the top and bottom of the panel and press. Sew a 2 1/2" x WOF Caramel Swirls strip to the top and bottom edges of the panel. Trim the excess fabric from the strip where it extends past the left and right edges and press. Trim this completed panel section and borders to measure 24 1/2" x 26 1/2".

2. Sew a row of blocks completed in step 2 above to the top and bottom of the quilt top and press.
3. Sew the 1 1/2" x 34 1/2" Rust Swirl strips to the sides of the quilt top and press toward the strip. Sew the 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" Rust Swirl strips to the top and bottom and press.
4. Sew the 3 1/2" x 36 1/2" Green Cup strips to the sides of the quilt and press toward the Green cup strip. Sew the remaining two Green Cup strips to the top and bottom and press.

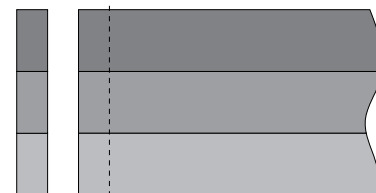

5. Create a strip set by sewing one of **each** 2 1/2" x WOF Rust Swirls, Aqua Beans and Green Swirls together and press. (*Note: When trimming off the selvage edges, carefully remove the **smallest** amount possible.*) Cut this strip set into twenty-six 1 1/2" sections. Diagram 2

6. Referring to the color photo and the diagram, sew seven of the sections completed in step 5 together to create one long strip.

- You may wish to change the color of the first piece on one of the strips to match the photo. Repeat to make two. Sew these strips to the sides of the quilt and press toward the center. Diagram 3
7. Again referring to the color photo and diagram, sew six sections together to make a long strip. Your strip will have one extra color. Remove one color from one of the ends. Again, you may wish to change the color of the first piece on one strip to match the photo. Repeat to make two. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the quilt and press toward the center.
 8. Sew the 4 1/2" x 44 1/2" Stripe strips to the sides of the quilt and press out. Sew a Block to each end of the 4 1/2" x 34 1/2" Stripe strips and press. Sew these strips to the top and bottom and press.
 9. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing together and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.
