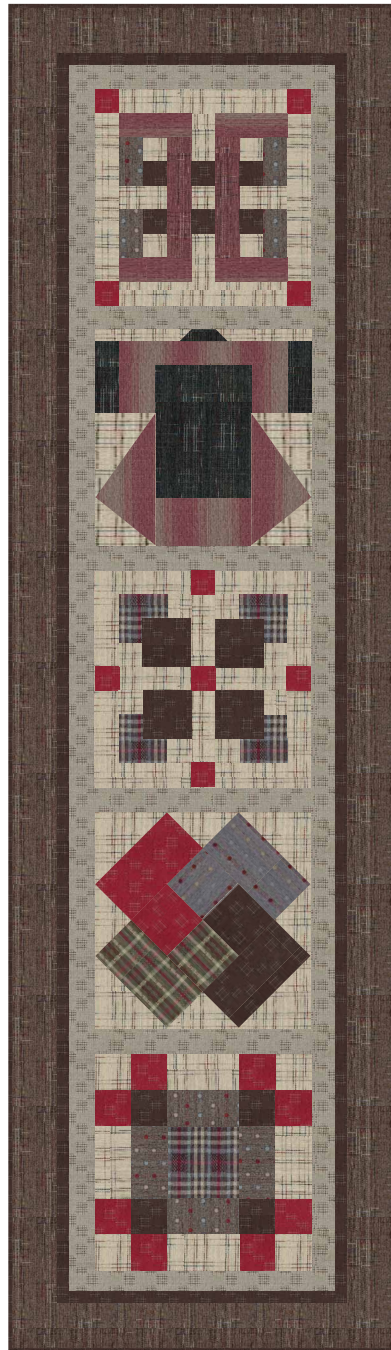

Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

1/8 yd	Red Small Toss	7282-4
3/8 yd	Khaki Small Toss	7282-12
1/2 yd	Dk Brown Small Toss	7282-16
1/8 yd	Blue Large Plaid	7299-16
1/8 yd	Brown Large Plaid	7299-15
1/8 yd	Brown w/Dots	7302-15
1/8 yd	Lavender w/Dots	7302-27
1/4 yd	Rose-Taupe Stripe	7303-4
1/8 yd	Rose Subtle Plaid	7306-4
1/4 yd	Gray Subtle Plaid	7306-7
1/2 yd	Khaki Subtle Plaid	7306-11
3/8 yd	Brown Subtle Plaid	7306-15

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

Cutting: The capital letters A through E below refer to the blocks from top to bottom: A – Knot, B – Kimono, C – Stacked Squares, D – Card Trick, E – Winged Square

From the Red Small Toss cut:

- 1 – 2-5/8" x 4-3/4" rectangle – D
- 1 – 2-5/8" square – D
- 8 – 2" x 2" squares – E
- 9 – 1-1/2" squares – A, C

From the Khaki Small Toss cut:

- 4 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips sewn end to end and cut into:
 - 2 – 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" border strips
 - 6 – 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles – sashing/ border strips

From the Dark Brown Small Toss cut:

- 4 – 1" x WOF strips – narrow inner border
- 4 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips - binding
- 1 – 2-5/8" x 4-3/4" rectangle – D
- 1 – 2-5/8" square - D
- 4 – 2-1/2" squares – C
- 4 – 2" squares – E
- 6 – 1-1/2" squares - A

From Blue Large Plaid cut:

- 1 – 3-1/2" square – E
- 4 – 2-1/2" x 1-1/2" rectangles - C
- 4 – 1-1/2" squares - C

Cut the Fabrics, con't.

From Brown Large Plaid cut:

- 1 – 2-5/8" x 4-3/4" rectangle – D
- 1 – 2-5/8" square - D

From Brown w/Dots cut:

- 4 – 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles - A
- 4 – 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles - E

From Lavender w/Dots cut:

- 1 – 2-5/8" x 4-3/4" rectangle – D
- 1 – 2-5/8" square - D

From Rose/Taupe Stripe cut:

- 4 – 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles (cut LOF on the rose stripe) – A
- 1 – 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle (cut WOF across the stripe) – B
- 2 – 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles (cut lengthwise on the stripe) – B
- 1 – 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle (cut WOF across the stripe) – B
- 2 – 3-1/8" x 6-7/8" rectangles (cut lengthwise on the stripe) – B (for 1 – Template K3 and 1 – K3 reverse – B)

From Rose Subtle Plaid cut:

- 2 – 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles – A

From Dark Gray Subtle Plaid cut:

- 1 – 4-1/2" x 6" rectangle – B
- 2 – 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles – B
- 1 – 1" x 2-3/4" rectangle – B

From Khaki Subtle Plaid cut:

- 1 – Template K1 and 1 - K1 reverse – B
- 1 – Template K2 and 1 – K2 reverse – B
- 1 – 4-1/4" square, cut diagonally twice – D
- 2 – 3-7/8" squares, cut diagonally once – D
- 3 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips cut into:
 - 4 – 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles – A
 - 4 – 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles – C
 - 8 – 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles – C
 - 4 – 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles – A
 - 13 – 1-1/2" squares – (5 for A, 8 for C)
 - 4 – 2" squares – E
 - 4 – 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles – E
 - 2 – 1" x 4-3/8" rectangles – B

From Brown Subtle Plaid cut:

- 4 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips – outer border

Construct the Blocks;

Block A - Knot

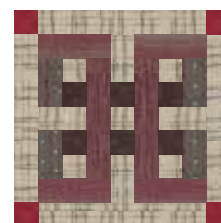
Block B - Kimono

Block C - Stacked Squares

Block D - Card Trick

Block E - Winged Square

Block A: Knot



1. Sew a Dark Brown 1-1/2" square to a Lt Khaki 1-1/2" square. Repeat for five total pairs. Press toward the dark square.
2. Sew a Brown w/Dots 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle to one long edge of a unit from Step 1. Make three more units, one unit the same as the first, and two as mirror images (Fig 1).

3. Sew two units just made to each long side of a Lt Khaki 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle. Repeat for two units total (Fig 2).

4. Sew a Rose Subtle Plaid 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to the long edge with dark squares of each unit from Step 4 (Fig 3).
5. Sew a Rose/Taupe Stripe 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to each short edge of the units from Step 4 (Fig 4). Make 2.

6. Sew a Dark Brown 1-1/2" square to the remaining unit from Step 1. Sew a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Lt Khaki rectangle to each end (Fig 5).

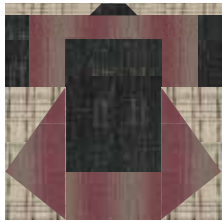

- Assemble the center of the block in rows. Then sew Red 1-1/2" squares to both ends of two of the Lt Khaki 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips (Fig 6). Press toward the red squares. Sew two Lt Khaki 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the block center. Press toward the block center. Sew the strips with red squares to the other two sides of the center. Press toward the center.

Block B: Kimono



- To make the "collar" for the kimono, place a 1" x 2-3/4" Dk Gray Subtle Plaid rectangle right sides together on one end of the 1" x 4-3/8" Lt Khaki rectangle as in shown Fig 7. Carefully sew on the diagonal. Trim the corner, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press toward the dark fabric.

- Place the other 1" x 4-3/8" Lt Khaki rectangle on the other end as shown in Fig 8. Carefully sew on the diagonal, trim the corner and press as above.
- To make the flared sides of the kimono, sew a Lt Khaki triangle (Template K1) to a Rose/Taupe Stripe triangle (Template K3) along the long edges (Fig.9). Line up the trimmed

corners of the Lt Khaki triangle with the edges of the Rose/Taupe triangle. Be careful not to stretch the bias edges as you sew. Press toward the darker fabric. Sew the Lt Khaki triangle (Template K2) triangle to the lower diagonal and press. Repeat with the K1 and K2 reverse pieces to the other Rose/Taupe Stripe triangle (Template K3 reverse) to make a second (mirror image). (Fig.9)

- To make the sleeves, sew a Dark Gray Subtle Plaid 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to a Rose/Taupe Stripe 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle along the long side. Press. Repeat for a second sleeve. Sew a sleeve to the top of each of the side units from Step 3.
- Sew the three pieces for the center of the kimono together. Press seams toward the Dark Gray Plaid.
- Assemble the block in three vertical rows (Fig 10). Press. Add the unit from Step 1 to the top edge to finish the block.

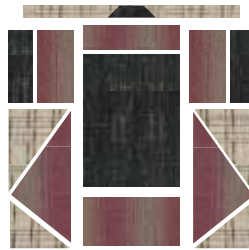
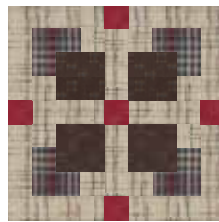

Block C: Stacked Squares



- Sew a 1-1/2" Blue Plaid square to a 1-1/2" Lt Khaki square. Repeat for four total pairs. Press toward the darker square.
- Sew a 2-1/2" Dk Brown Small Toss square to the right edge (Blue Plaid square on top) of the unit just made (Fig 11). Press toward the dark square.
- Sew a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Blue Plaid rectangle to a 1-1/2" Lt Khaki square. Repeat for four total pairs. Press toward the darker rectangle.

- Sew a unit from Step 3 to the edge of a unit from Step 2, placing the plaid pieces adjacent to each other (Fig 12). Press toward the dark square. Sew a 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Lt Khaki rectangle to the top edge of the unit from Step 3 (Fig 12). Sew a 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Lt Khaki rectangle to the left edge (Fig 12). Repeat for four total units.

- Sew a Red Toss 1-1/2" square to a Lt Khaki 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Repeat for four units. Arrange these with the four pieced squares and one 1-1/2" Red Toss square (center).
- Sew the three units on top together to make one section, then the three in the middle strip and finally the three on the bottom. Sew the three sections together to complete the square (Fig 13).

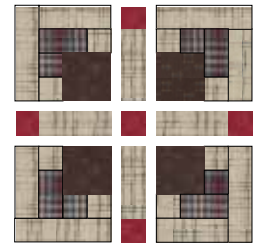
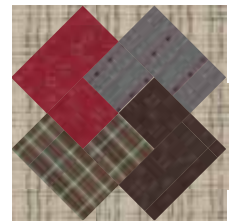

Block D: Card Trick



- Start with the center four patch. Sew a Red Small Toss 2-5/8" square to a Brown Large Plaid 2-5/8" square. Press toward the red square. Sew a Lavender w/Dots 2-5/8" square to a Dk Brown Small Toss 2-5/8" square. Press toward the dark brown square. Sew the two units together with the red square adjacent to the Lavender w/Dots square (Fig 14).
- Sew the Brown Large Plaid 2-5/8" x 4-3/4" rectangle to the left edge of the red and green plaid unit just made (the red square on top – Fig. 15). Sew the Lavender w/ Dots 2-5/8" x 4-3/4" rectangle to the opposite edge. Press seams toward the rectangles.

- Sew a large Lt Khaki triangle to the other long edge of each rectangle just sewn. Press toward the rectangles (Fig 15).

- Sew small triangles of Lt Khaki Subtle Plaid to each short edge of the Red Small Toss 2-5/8" x 4-3/4" rectangle. Repeat with the Dk Brown Small Toss 2-5/8" x 4-3/4" rectangle (Fig 16). Press toward the darker fabrics. Sew a large Lt Khaki triangle to one long edge of each of the units just sewn. Press toward the dark fabrics.
- Sew the block together in three diagonal rows, carefully matching the seams of the Red Small Toss and the Dk Brown Small Toss fabrics. Press seams toward the center unit (Fig 16).

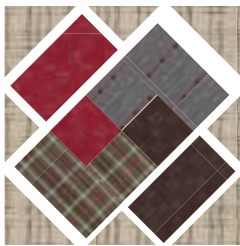
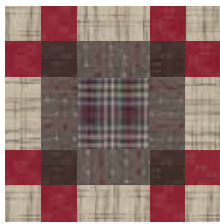

Block E: Winged Square



- Starting with the outer corners, sew four Red Small Toss 2" squares to four Lt Khaki Plaid 2" squares (Fig 17). Press toward the red squares. Sew four Red Small Toss 2" squares to four Dk Brown Toss 2" squares. Press toward the red squares. Sew one of each unit together to make a four-patch (Fig 17). Make a total of four.

- Sew a 2" x 3-1/2" Lt Khaki Plaid rectangle to a 2" x 3-1/2" Brown w/Dots rectangle on the long edges. Press toward the Brown w/Dots fabric. Repeat for four units.
- Sew two units from step 1 to each end of a unit from step 2 (Fig 18). Press toward the red fabric. Repeat once more for a total of two units.
- Sew two units from step 2 to each side of Blue Large Plaid 3-1/2" square (Fig 18). Press toward the Blue Plaid fabric.
- Complete the block by sewing the three units together in three horizontal rows. Press away from the center (Fig. 18).

Assemble the Quilt:

- Sew a 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" Khaki Small Toss strip to the top edge of each of the five blocks. Sew the last strip to the bottom of the Winged Square block. Press toward the sashing strips.
- Sew the blocks together to form the center of the quilt. Press toward the sashing.
- Sew a 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" Khaki Small Toss strip to each side of the quilt. Press toward the sashing.
- Measure the length of the center and cut two Dark Brown Small Toss strips to that measurement. (Piece strips together to make strips long enough.) Sew to each sides of the quilt center. Press toward the dark brown fabric.
- Measure the width of the center and cut two Dark Brown Small Toss strips to that measurement. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the dark brown fabric.
- Measure the length of the center and cut two Brown Subtle Plaid strips to that measurement. (Piece strips together to make strips long enough.) Press toward the dark brown fabric.
- Measure the width of the center and cut two Brown Subtle Plaid strips to that measurement. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the dark brown fabric.
- Layer with batting and backing. Quilt, bind and label to finish.
