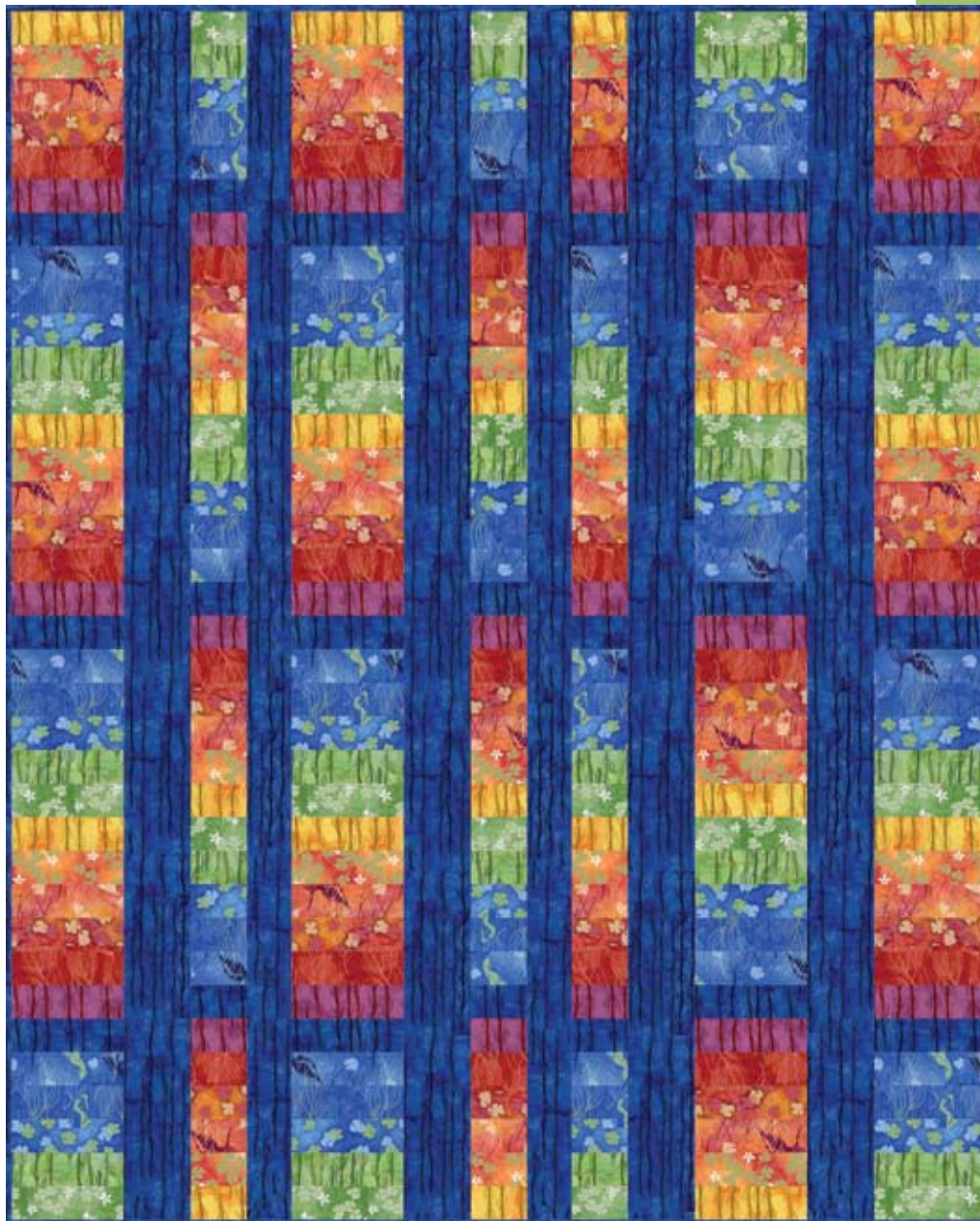

Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- ¼ Yard - Sunset Large Leaves (F0007-1)
- ¼ Yard - Blue Large Leaves (F0007-2)
- ¼ Yard - Sunset Small Leaves (F0009-1)
- ¼ Yard - Sunset Floral (F0010-1)
- ¼ Yard - Blue Small Leaves (F0009-2)
- ¼ Yard - Green Floral (F0010-3)
- 1¾ Yard - Blue Bamboo (F0006-2)
- ¼ Yard - Green Bamboo (F0006-3)
- ¼ Yard - Gold Bamboo (F0006-4)
- ¼ Yard - Burgundy Bamboo (F0006-5)
- ¼ Yard - Red Branches (F0008-1)
- ¼ Yard - Blue Branches (F0008-2)
- 3 Yards backing of your choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric
LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Sunset Large Leaves cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

From the Blue Large Leaves cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

From the Sunset Small Leaves cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

From the Sunset Floral cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

From the Blue Small Leaves cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

From the Green Floral cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

From the Blue Bamboo cut:
3 – 2" x WOF
4 – 2½" x LOF (binding)
4 – 3½" x LOF
2 – 2½" x LOF

From the Green Bamboo cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

From the Gold Bamboo cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

From the Burgandy Bamboo cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

From the Red Branches cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

From the Blue Branches cut:
3 – 2" x WOF

Directions

Rainbow Strips

1. Make a strip set by sewing together a 2" x WOF from each of the fabrics in the order show in the diagram. Press after each strip is sewn. Repeat for a total of 3 strips sets. Figure 1
2. Cut the strips sets completed in step one into twelve 5½" sections and nine 3" sections.
3. Sew three of the 5½" strip set sections together to make one long rainbow strip.

- Repeat to make a total of four 5½" rainbow strips.
4. Sew three of the 3" strip set sections together to make one long rainbow strip. Repeat to make a total of three 3" rainbow strips.

Putting it Together

1. Referring to the diagram sew the rainbow strips and Blue Bamboo LOF strips together as shown and press toward the Blue Bamboo strips. Pay special attention to the size and color placement of the rainbow strips as well as the directional print of the Blue Bamboo strips. Trim the excess of the Blue Bamboo strips as needed. Figure 2
2. To help reinforce the sides of the quilt top, stitch along the side edges a scant ¼". This will help prevent the seams from coming loose during quilting.
3. Layer quilt top, batting and backing together and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.

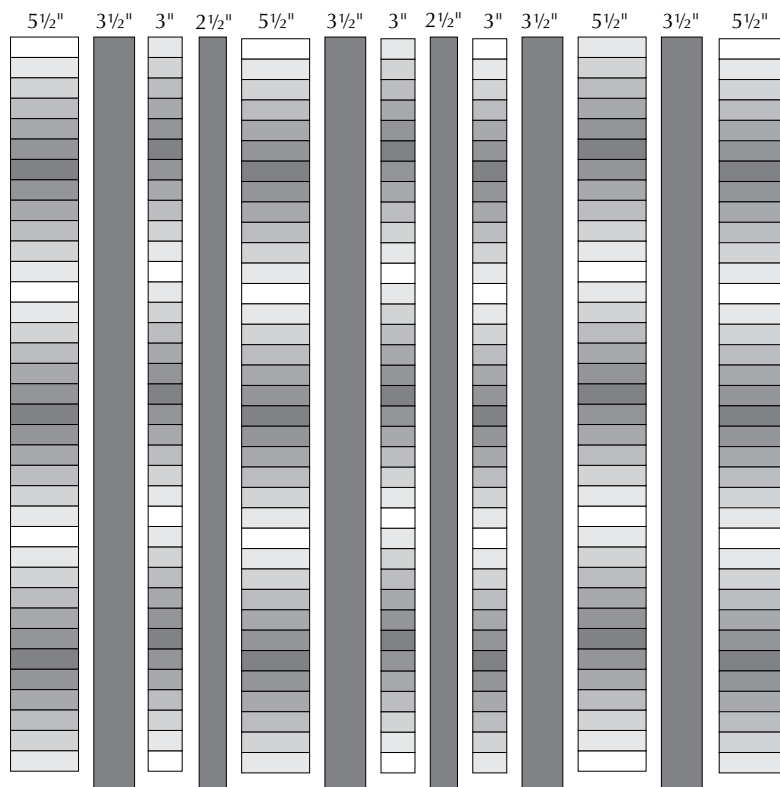
