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## Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

### Materials

1/2 yard Light yellow paisley fabric (Y0443-8)  
 1 yard Stripe fabric (Y0438-29)  
 1/4 yard Yellow large print (Y0439-8)  
 1/8 yard Blue multi-paisley (Y0440-29)  
 1/4 yard Yellow multi-paisley (Y0440-8)  
 1/8 yard Green bee print (Y0441-23)  
 1/4 yard Purple bee print (Y0441-26)  
 1/8 yard Blue bee print (Y0441-29)  
 1/8 yard Green vine (Y0442-23)  
 3/8 yard Purple vine (Y0442-26)  
 1/8 yard Green paisley (Y0443-24)  
 1/8 yard Purple paisley (Y0443-27)  
 1/8 yard Blue paisley (Y0443-30)  
 1-1/4 yards Backing fabric of choice  
 1/2 yd fusible web (based on 17" width)

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

### From the Light yellow paisley background cut:

1 – 14" square

4 – 8" squares

### From the Stripe print cut:

4 – 3-1/2" wide x LOF strips (border)

### From the Yellow large print cut:

2 – 3-1/2" x 24-1/2" lengths (border)

### From the Blue multi-paisley cut:

2 – reversed small prepared fusible appliqué umbrella shapes

### From the Yellow multi-paisley cut:

8 – 3-7/8" squares

1 – large prepared fusible umbrella shape

### From the Green bee print cut:

8 – 3-7/8" squares

### From the Purple bee print cut:

4 – 2" wide x WOF strips (border)

### From the Blue bee print cut:

8 – 3-7/8" squares

### From the Green vine cut:

8 – 3-7/8" squares

### From the Purple vine cut:

4 – 2-1/2" wide x WOF strips (binding)

2 – small prepared fusible umbrella shapes

### From the Green paisley cut:

1 – large prepared fusible umbrella handle

### From the Purple paisley cut:

2 – small prepared fusible umbrella handles

### From the Blue paisley cut:

2 – reversed small prepared fusible umbrella handles

3 – prepared fusible rain drop shapes

### Making the Pieced Blocks

1. Pencil a diagonal line on the backs of the eight 3-7/8" yellow multi-paisley squares and the eight 3-7/8" green bee print squares as shown in figure 1.
2. Pair right sides together eight yellow multi-paisley squares and eight green vine squares. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the penciled line on one of the pairs. Cut the square in half on the penciled line and finger press open the half square triangle as shown in figure 2. Repeat to complete the 8 pairs and make 16 half square triangles.
3. Repeat to pair eight green bee print squares and eight blue bee print squares and make 16 half square triangles.
4. Sew together two yellow multi-paisley half square triangles and two blue bee print half square triangles into a block as shown in figure 3. Repeat to make eight finished 6-1/2" blocks and press the blocks.

### Making the Umbrella Appliquéd Blocks

1. Center and fuse to the 14" light yellow paisley background block one large yellow multi-paisley umbrella shape, one large green paisley handle and three blue paisley rain drops as shown in the quilt picture. Machine finish the appliqué edges with a small zigzag stitch. Press the block and **trim to 12-1/2" square**.
2. Center and fuse on one 8" light yellow paisley background block one purple vine small umbrella shape and one small purple paisley handle. Finish the appliqué edges and repeat to make the second purple vine umbrella block. Press the blocks and trim to 6-1/2".
3. Repeat to make two blue multi-paisley umbrella blocks using reversed shapes for the umbrella and the blue paisley handles. Trim the blocks to 6-1/2".

### Sewing the Wall Hanging Together

1. Lay out the pieced blocks and umbrella blocks as shown in the quilt picture. Sew the blocks together into three vertical rows. Sew the rows together. Press the quilt center.

### Adding the Borders

1. Sew a 3-1/2" x 24-1/2" yellow large print border to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
2. Measure the length of the quilt center. Trim two 2" wide purple bee print strips to that length and sew to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
3. Measure the width of the quilt center. Trim the two remaining 2" wide purple bee print strips to that length and sew to the top and bottom sides of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
4. Repeat to add the outside border using 3-1/2" wide fussy cut strips of the striped fabric. Press the seams outward.

### Finishing the Wall Hanging

1. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and baste for quilting. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess batting and backing from the outside border.
2. Make the binding from the 2-1/2" wide purple vine strips and apply to the quilt.

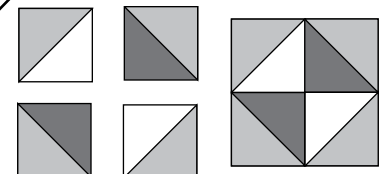
