Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide unwashed fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

1 $\frac{7}{8}$ Black Tonal (Y0665-3)(includes binding)
 ½ yd Green Tonal (Y0665-24)
 ½ yd Red Stripe (Y0666-4)
 ¼ yd Grey Stripe (Y0666-7)
 1 yd Red/White Med. Floral (Y0667-4)
 ½ yd Red/White Sm. Floral (Y0668-1)
 ⅞ yd Pink/Red Lg. Floral (Y0669-4)
 3½ yd Backing of your choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric
 LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Black Tonal cut:

11 – 2½" x WOF (6 are for binding)
 24 – 4½" squares
 24 – 2⅞" squares
 72 – 2½" squares

From the Green Tonal cut:

24 – 2⅞" squares
 24 – 2½" squares

From the Red Stripe cut:

5 – 1½" x WOF
 6 – 4 ½" squares

From the Grey Stripe cut:

24 – 2½" squares

From the Red/White Med. Floral cut:

6 – 5½" x WOF

From the Red/White Sm. Floral cut:

24 – 4½" squares

From the Pink/Red Lg. Floral cut:

6 – 12½" squares

Flower Block - Finished Size: 12" x 12"

1. With a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2½" Grey Stripe squares. Watching direction of the stripe, place one of these squares on the corner of a 4½" Red Stripe square and sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance to within ¼" of the seam and press open. Repeat on the remaining corners as shown. Diagram 1.

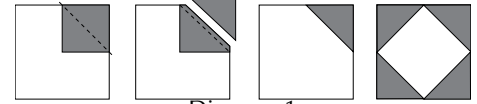

2. As you did in step 1, draw a diagonal on the wrong side of forty-eight 2½" Black Tonal squares. Place one of the squares on the top right corner of a 4½" Sm. Red/White Floral square and sew and trim as you did in step 1. Repeat on the Top left corner as shown. Make a total of twenty-four petal units. Diagram 2.

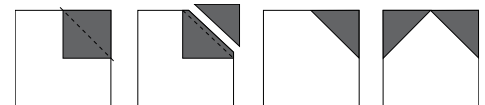

3. Watching placement, sew two petal units from step 2 to the right and left side of a unit from step 1, press. Repeat to make six. Refer to Diagram 5 if needed.
4. Using a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2⅞" Green Tonal squares. Place one of these squares on top of a 2⅞" Black Tonal square and sew ¼" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press each side open. Repeat to make forty-eight half-triangle squares. Diagram 3.

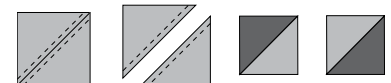

5. Using two units from step 4, a 2½" Green Tonal square and a 2½" Black Tonal square sew the units together as shown. Repeat to make twenty-four leaf units. Diagram 4.
6. Sew two leaf units from step 5 to the right and left sides of one of the remaining units from step 2. Repeat to make twelve. Sew these completed units to the top and bottom of the units from step 3. Repeat to make six Flower Blocks. Diagram 5.

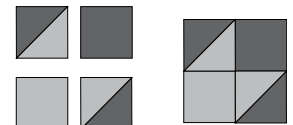

Alternate Block - Finished Size: 12" x 12"

1. Using the same technique used above in step 1, sew the 4½" Black Tonal squares to the corners of the 12½" Pink/Red Lg. Floral squares. Make a total of six.

Putting It Together

1. Referring to the color photo, layout the blocks you have completed into four rows of three blocks per row, alternating the blocks in each row. Sew the blocks together into rows pressing the rows in opposite directions. Sew the rows together, press.
2. Sew five of the 2½" x WOF Black Tonal strips together end to end to make one long strip. Sew this strip to the right side of the quilt top, press and trim excess. Repeat on the left, top and bottom.
3. Repeat step 2 using the 1½" x WOF Red Stripe strips.
4. Repeat step 2 using the 5½" x WOF Med. Red/White Floral strips.
5. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.

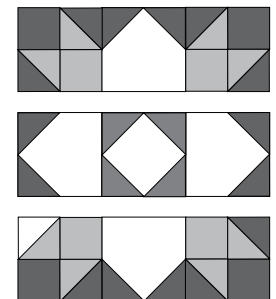
