## Materials

*Yardages based on 42" wide fabric*

Materials:

- 3/8 yd Red/Pink Solid (Y0600-4)
- 3/8 yd Yellow/Green Solid (Y0600-19)
- 3/8 yd Blue/Aqua Solid (Y0600-31)
- 1/4 yd Aqua/Red/Navy Dots (Y0595-33)
- 1/4 yd Aqua/Green/Orange Dots (Y0595-19)
- 1/4 yd Red/Orange/Pink Dot Blocks (Y0597-4)  
(minimum two full rows of blocks x WOF)
- 1/4 yd Blue/ Green Dot Blocks (Y0597-31)  
(minimum two full rows of blocks x WOF)
- 3/8 yd Blue Plaid (Y0598-31)
- 3/4 yd Red Stripe (Y0599-9)
- 1½ yds Green Plaid (Y0598-19) (border)
- 3/8 yd Blue/green Stripe (Y0599-19) Binding
- 3 yds Backing of choice
- 4 yds Fusible Webbing (based on 17" wide)

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

### From Red/Pink, Yellow/Green and Blue/Aqua Solids cut:

50 (total) – 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles, with approximately half the rectangles from warm tones (red, pink and yellow) and half from cool tones (green, cobalt and aqua).

### From Aqua/Green/Orange Dots and Aqua/Red/Navy Dots (First: apply fusible webbing to the back of each fabric) fussy cut:

25 - approx. 2-3/4" x 3" rectangles of assorted colors, fussy cut to include white stripes on the left and right side edges and with 4 circles inside the block (see quilt image).

### From Red/Orange/Pink and Blue/Aqua/Green Dot Blocks (First: apply fusible webbing to the back of each fabric) fussy cut:

13 – blocks, fussy cut following the white outer edge of the blocks. Then cut all of these in half diagonally to form the roofs.

### From Blue Plaid cut:

36 – 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares, fussy cut centering each block to include 4 aqua squares.

### From Red Stripe cut:

60 – 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles (sashing)

### From Green Plaid cut:

4 - 4-1/2"–LOF strips (border)

### From Blue/Green Stripe cut:

6 – 2-1/4" x WOF strips (binding)

### Instructions:

#### Construction of House Blocks: Use 1/4" seam for all piecing.

1. Sew two solid rectangles together along the long edge, right sides together. Press seam open. See quilt image for color combinations. Blocks will alternate warm to cool colors every other block for a total of 25 background blocks, each measuring 6-1/2" square.
2. Arrange the house blocks and roof pieces on top of the background squares and press into place. Follow manufacturer's recommended settings for the fusible. Leave the edges raw or satin stitch the pieces into place (see fusible manufacturer's recommendations).

#### Assemble the quilt:

1. Arrange the house blocks in rows with the sashing between each block on the sides, top and bottom (see quilt image). Place corner blocks in between as shown.
2. Stitch the corner blocks and sashing rectangles together by row into strips.
3. Stitch the sashing and house blocks together by row into strips.
4. Join the strips to complete the center of the quilt.

#### Finishing the Quilt:

1. Measure the quilt from top to bottom and trim two side borders to that measurement. Sew them to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the border.
2. Measure the quilt from side to side and trim two borders to that measurement. Sew them to the top and the bottom of the quilt center.
3. Make a quilt back that is slightly larger than the quilt top, approximately 54" square. Layer the back, batting and quilt top, baste and quilt. Trim the edges and apply binding around the entire edge of the quilt.
