Materials *Yardages based on 42" wide fabric*

Green Table Runner w/ wine bag

- 1-1/4 yds - Large Stripe (19081-1)
- 5/8 yd - Green w/ Red Grapes (19083-3)
- 1/4 yd - Cream Words (19084-1)
- 1/4 yd - Green Words (19084-3)
- 1/4 yd - Green Wine Glasses (19082-3)
- 1/4 yd - Cream Wine Glasses (19082-1)
- 3/4 yd - Wine Words (19084-2)
- 1-3/4 yds - Backing of your choice

Black Table Runner w/ wine bag

- 1-1/4 yds - Large Stripe (19081-1)
- 5/8 yd - Cream Wine Blocks (19080-1)
- 1/2 yd - Cream w/ Red Grapes (19083-1)
- 1 yd - Black Words (19084-7)
- 1/4 yd - Cream Words (19084-1)
- 1/4 yd - Cream Wine Glasses (19082-1)
- 1-3/4 yds - Backing of your choice



Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric
LOF = Length of Fabric

Table Runner

***Black version in (Parenthesis)**

From Large Stripe cut: (both versions)

- Fussy cut one strip 6-1/2" x 42-1/2" centered over the wine bottle motif.

From the Cream Wine Blocks cut: (black version only)

- 1- 19 1/4" square. Cut the square twice diagonally into quarters.

From the Green w/ Red Grapes (Cream w/ Red Grapes) cut:

- 7- 6 1/2" squares. (Both versions)
- 1- 14" square. Cut the square on one diagonal. (Green version only)

From the Cream Words cut: (both versions)

- 6- 3 1/2" squares.

From the Green Words (Black Words) cut:

- 8 (14 for black version)- 3 1/2" squares.

From the Green Wine Glasses cut: (green version only)

- 6- 3 1/2" squares.

From the Cream Wine Glasses cut: (both versions)

- 8- 3 1/2" squares.

From the Wine Words (Black Words) cut:

- 2- 1 1/2" x 18-1/2" strips.
- 4- 2 1/4" x WOF strips for binding.

From the Backing cut:

- 1- 24" x 65"

Wine Bag

- Cut one 16" (w) x 18" (h) rectangle each from the main fabric and lining fabric for the bag.
- Cut one 3" by WOF strip from the tie fabric (or use ribbon or cord for the tie.)

Table Runner Directions

1. Sew together two 3-1/2" Green (Cream) Wine Glass squares and two 3-1/2" Cream (Black) Words squares to make one 4-patch block. Repeat to make three Cream Words (Cream Wine Glass) 4-patch blocks.
2. Sew together two 3-1/2" Cream Wine Glass (Cream Words) squares and two 3-1/2" Green Words to make one 4-patch block. Repeat to make four Green (Black) Word 4-patch blocks.
3. Refer to the quilt photo for block placement and sew together two Cream (Black) Words 4-patch blocks, two Green Words (Cream Wine Glass) 4-patch and three 6-1/2" Green w/ Red (Cream w/ Red) Grapes squares to make the top row.
4. Refer to the quilt photo for block placement and sew together one Cream (Black) Words 4-patch block, two Green Words (Cream Wine Glass) 4-patch and four 6-1/2" Green (Cream) w/ Red Grapes squares to make the bottom row.
5. Sew the top pieced row, the 6-1/2" x 42-1/2" wine bottle strip and the bottom pieced row together to make the runner top.
6. Sew one 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" Wine (Black) Words strip to each end of the runner.
7. Center one Green w/ Red Grapes (Cream Wine Blocks) triangle to one end of the runner and sew in place. Trim the triangles to match the runner. Repeat with the remaining triangle and the other side of the runner.
8. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

Wine Bag Directions

Assemble the Bag:

1. Fold the main fabric bag lengthwise right sides together. Stitch across the bottom of the bag and up the side to the top edge.
2. Repeat with the lining fabric, except leave 3" opening for turning in the side seam (at least 2" up from the bottom corner). Trim corners. Press seams open.
3. Square up the bottom of both bags by making triangle points of the corners one at a time. Center the seam in the middle of the triangle and measure 1-1/2" in from the point (Fig.1). Draw a line perpendicular to the seam and stitch on the line. Trim the point leaving 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat for all four corners. (2 each main fabric bag and lining)
4. Place the bag lining (right side out) inside the main fabric bag (inside out), matching the top edges and the side seams (right sides together). Stitch the top edge all around.
5. Turn the bag right side out through the opening in the side seam of the lining. Slip stitch the opening closed. Drop the lining into the bag. Press the top edge and top stitch close to the edge, if desired.
6. To make the tie, take the 3" x WOF strip and cut it to 40", or desired length plus 1".
7. Fold over 1/2" of the material on each end and sew in place to create a finished edge (Fig.2).
8. Fold each long side in to the center of the strip (Fig.3). Press. Fold the strip in half lengthwise again (Fig. 4). Press.
