

Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1/4 Yard - Green Owls (Y0583-24)
- 1/2 Yard - Brown Owls (Y0583-15)
includes binding
- 1/4 Yard - Green Woodland (Y0581-24)
- 1/4 Yard - Gold Woodland (Y0581-9)
- 3/8 Yard - Orange Tonal Trees (Y0582-36)
- 3/8 Yard - Green Tonal Trees (Y0582-24)
- 1/4 Yard - Gold Tonal Trees (Y0582-9)
- 1-1/4 Yard - backing of your choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Green Owls cut:

- 5 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares

From Brown Owls cut:

- 5 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares
- 4 - 2 1/2" WOF strips for the binding.

From the Green Woodland cut:

- 5 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares

From the Gold Woodland cut:

- 5 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares

From the Orange Tonal Trees cut:

- 7 - 1 1/2" WOF strips, cut into
 - 14 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and
 - 14 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

From the Green Tonal Trees cut:

- 7 - 1 1/2" WOF strips, cut into
 - 14 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and
 - 14 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

From the Gold Tonal Trees cut:

- 5 - 1 1/2" WOF strips, cut into
 - 12 - 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and
 - 12 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

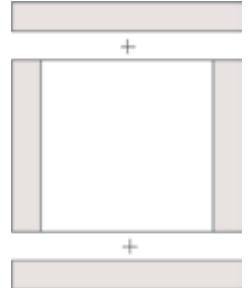
Directions

Blocks - Finished Size 8 1/2" square

Make the following total number of blocks:

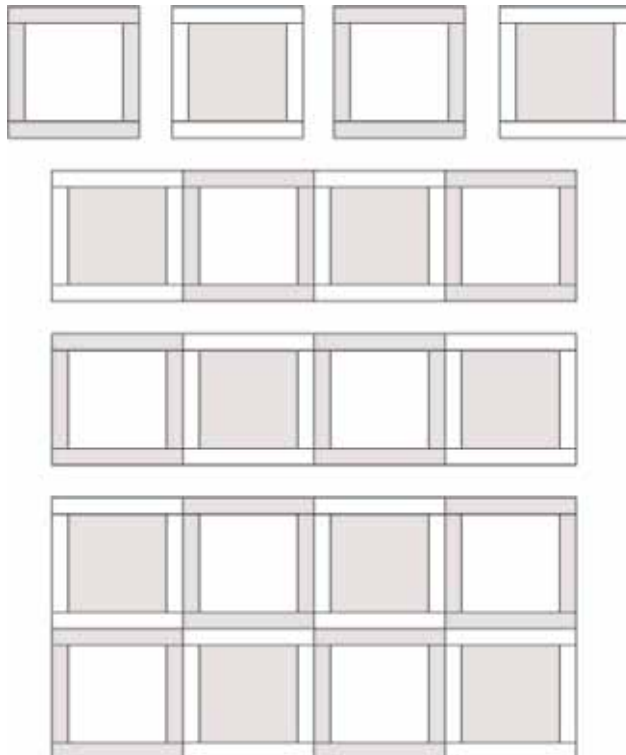
- 7 Orange Tonal Trees blocks, consisting of 4 Gold Woodland centers, 2 Green Owl centers, and 1 Green Woodland center.
- 7 Green Tonal Trees blocks, consisting of 3 Brown Owl centers, 2 Green Owl centers, 1 Green Woodland center, and 1 Gold Woodland center.
- 6 Gold Tonal Trees blocks, consisting of 3 Green Woodland centers, 2 Brown Owl centers, and 1 Green Owl center.

1. With right sides together, sew a 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle to each side of the 6 1/2" center block square. Press seams towards the rectangles.
2. Sew a 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom of the center block unit. Press seams towards the rectangles.



Putting it Together

1. Using the color photo on the front for block placement, arrange the blocks into rows.
2. Sew the blocks together in each row. Press.
3. Sew the rows together to create the quilt top. Press.
4. Layer quilt top, batting and backing together and quilt as desired.
5. Add the binding to the quilt.
