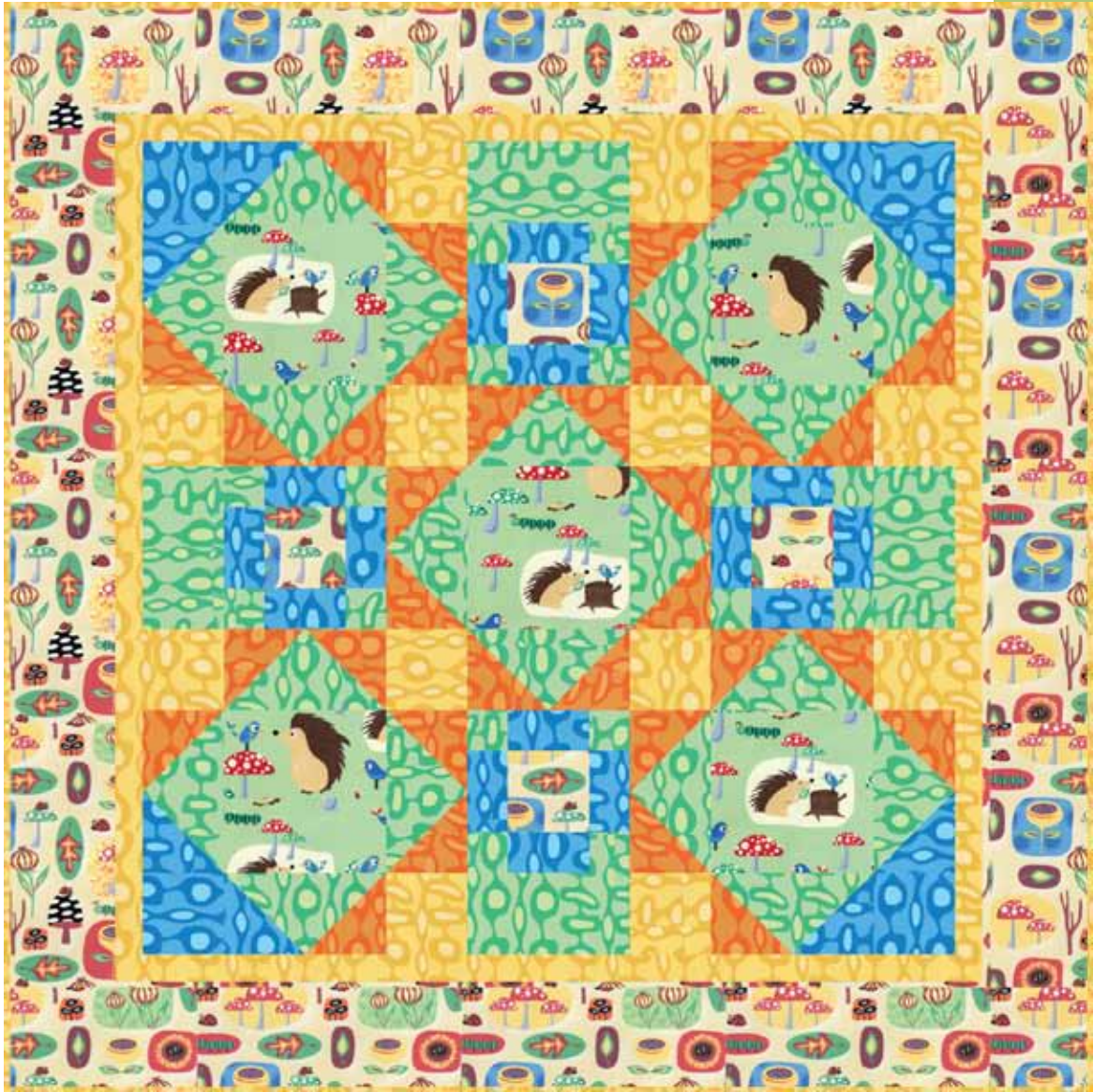


Woodland Friends

Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

1/4 yd Green Hedgehogs
 7/8 yd Cream Leaves and Mushrooms
 3/4 yd Yellow Peapod Stripe (includes binding)
 5/8 yd Green Peapod Stripe
 3/8 yd Blue Peapod Stripe
 3/8 yd Orange Peapod Stripe
 1-1/4 yd Backing – Suggested
 RustHedgehogs

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Green Hedgehogs cut:

5 – 6-1/2" squares

From the Cream Leaves and Mushrooms cut:

2 – 4-1/2" x WOF

4 – 4-1/2" x LOF

4 – 3-1/2" squares

From the Yellow Peapod Stripe cut:

1 – 3-1/2" WOF strip cut into

12 – 3-1/2" squares

4 – 1-1/2" x WOF strips

5 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips (binding)

From the Green Peapod Stripe cut:

4 – 3-1/2" x WOF strips cut into

24 – 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

2 – 2" x WOF strips

From the Blue Peapod Stripe cut:

1 – 3-1/2" x WOF strip cut into

12 – 3-1/2" squares

1 – 3-1/2" x WOF strip

1 – 2" x WOF strip cut into

8 – 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles

From the Orange Peapod Stripe cut:

3 – 3-1/2" x WOF strips cut into

32 – 3-1/2" squares

Directions

Use 1/4" seam allowances.

Instructions:

Making the Blocks – Make the Flying Geese units:

1. Draw a diagonal line with a pencil across the reverse sides of the thirty-two 3-1/2" Orange Peapod squares and eight 3-1/2" Blue Peapod squares.
2. Position an Orange Peapod square on the right corner of a 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Green Peapod rectangle (Fig. 1). Sew on the pencil line. Press out to cover the inner corner (Fig. 2). Trim the extra fabric underneath to 1/4" seam allowance.
3. Position another Orange Peapod square on the left corner of the same rectangle. Sew on the pencil line, press and trim as above (Fig.3)
4. Repeat Steps 2 and 3 for a total of twelve flying geese units.
5. To make the flying geese units with one blue corner, repeat Step 2 and 3 using Blue Peapod squares for one corner (Fig. 4). Make a total of eight flying geese units with one blue corner, four with blue on the left and four with blue on the right.

Sew the pieced block centers:

1. Sew a 2" Green Peapod strip to each side of the 3-1/2" Blue Peapod strip (Fig. 5). Press the seams toward the blue strip. Cut into eight 2" sections.
2. Sew a 2" x 3-1/2" Blue Peapod rectangle to the top and bottom edges of a Cream Leaves and Mushrooms 3-1/2" square. Press seams toward the blue rectangles. Repeat for a total of four sections.
3. Sew a section from Step 1 to each side of a section from Step 2. Press seams toward the blue. Repeat for a total of four pieced block centers.

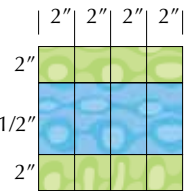

Assemble the seven horizontal rows for the center of the quilt:

1. From left to right for Row 1, sew a Blue Peapod 3-1/2" square to a flying geese rectangle as in Fig. 6. Press toward the outer blue square.
2. Add a Yellow Peapod 3-1/2" square to the other end of the flying geese rectangle, pressing toward the yellow square.
3. Continuing across, sew a Green Peapod rectangle, Yellow Peapod square, flying geese section and Blue Peapod square in the order shown. Press seams toward the yellow and blue squares.
4. Repeat Step 1 through Step 3 to make Row 7 (same as Row 1 rotated).
5. Lay out the sections for Rows 2 and 6 as shown. Sew sections together and press seams toward the block centers.
6. Rows 3 and 5 are the same (Row 5 is rotated). Sew and press seams toward the yellow squares.
7. Row 4 is similar to Rows 2 and 6. Sew and press toward the block centers.
8. Sew the rows together, matching seams, pinning if necessary. Press seams toward the rows with the block centers.

Add the borders:

1. Measure the quilt center from top to bottom. Cut two 1-1/2" Yellow Peapod strips to this length and sew to each side of the quilt center. Press the seams out toward the strips. Measure the quilt center from top to bottom. Cut two 1-1/2" Yellow Peapod strips to this length and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press out.
2. Sew two 4-1/2" x LOF Cream Leaves and Mushrooms strips together on the short edge (with images in proper direction) to make one long strip. Press. Repeat to make a second strip. Measure the quilt center from top to bottom. Cut and sew these strips to the left and right sides of the quilt. Press toward the border strips. Measure the quilt center from top to bottom. Cut the 2 – 4-1/2" x WOF strips to length and sew to the top and the bottom of the quilt. Press toward the border strips.
3. Layer and quilt as desired. Bind and label to finish.
